- International Relations: the geopolitical scenarios of Contemporary Russia and Russian concept of Foreign policy; the Russian factor in the Balkans; the problems border in the Caucasus area; the US' policy towards Latin America during the Cold War; the Forbidden stage: Argentina and the Soviet Union; the main directions of Cuban foreign policy;
- History of Kazakhstan: Kazakh culture: Silk Road tradition and the fate of the national culture; the Russian empire and Turkestan region; the Eurasian integration during the 1990s of 20th of 21st century; the Education system of Republic of Kazakhstan;
- History of Ukraine: Soviet past the Greek identity; the Ukrainian paucity every day life; the Azeri Greeks in the Crimea; the crisis of post-Soviet Ukraine identity.
